

THE HAWK EUROPEAN TOUR 2007

For the first time, Hawk Clothing are organising their first skate competition on a European scale.

The competition will incorporate the following 5 pre-selection events; Hall 04 (Hossegor, France), Barcelona (Spain), Nantes (France), Milan (Italy), London (UK) The final will be held in Biarritz (France).

There is no limit to the number of entrants in each of the 5 pre-selection events.

At each event, riders from the Hawk team will be present for demonstrations, hands-on skate advice and to judge the contests.

The event is specially intended for skaters (male and female) under the age of 18.

There will be 3 categories: [boys 10-14], [boys 14-18], [girls under 18].

Each participant will receive a prize. The winner of each pre-selection event will win a trip to the grand final in Biarritz (France).

The winner of each category (at the final) will win a ticket for 2 to skate in the United States.

The concept in brief:

Free competition entry 12 to 6pm (Skatepark entry £6 per person) and open to all amateur skaters under 18.

The skaters will be judged on their best series of tricks within 3 disciplines:
Manny pad, ledge and flat.

For the events held in skateparks, the format will be different. The judges will be scoring on 4 criteria:

1. Difficulty of tricks performed.
2. Style, control and execution.
3. Originality and innovative use of the skatepark.
4. Motivation.

The final will be held on the 7 July 2007 in Biarritz.

RULES OF THE HAWK EUROPEAN TOUR 2007

Entry Conditions:

▪ The competition is open to boys and girls under **18 years of age on the day of the final** (7 July 2007 in Biarritz).

The competitors will be grouped in 3 categories:

-Boys 10-14 years old (born between 4 June 1993 and 4 June 1997).

-Boys 14-18 years old (born between 4 June 1997 and 4 June 1989).

-Girls under 18 (born before 4 June 1997).

▪ The registration forms are available from our website www.hawk-city.com. They should be downloaded, completed and signed then sent to : The skate-park or the shop which is supporting the event. You must clearly state the event number, the town in which you wish to compete and the date of the event.

▪ Registration methods for the 5 pre-selection stages :

The Wednesday before the event at 7pm in the supporting shops.

The Thursday evening before the event on-line at www.hawk-city.com before 8pm.

The day of the competition at 10am.

The registration documents must be completed and consist of :

A registration form.

A responsibility disclaimer from each competitor.

A parental consent form from the parents of all minors.

A completed profile form from the internet site accompanied by a photo.

This will be a free competition. Travel expenses are to be paid by the competitors themselves. Only those who qualify for the final (and their legal Guardian) will be refunded their travel expenses to Biarritz and only upon confirmation by Wifried Stephan and the receipt of all necessary documentation and travel receipts. The arrangement and the charges linked to accommodation the night before the final will be taken in charge by the organisers.

All incomplete documents will be invalid.

Protection:

It is essential that all competitors and participants wear a helmet. Kneepads and elbow pads are strongly advised by the organisers.

2. Barcelona (Spain) 7 April 2007.
3. Nantes (France) 21 April 2007.
4. Milan (Italie) 20 May 2007.
5. London (UK) 16 June 2007.
6. Final – Biarritz (France) 7 July 2007.

The organisers reserve the right to modify and shorten the aforementioned schedule with no justification or warning.

Competition format:

This may vary depending on the number of entrants.

Competition Structure:

First, second and third place winners of the pre-selection events [Boys 10-14 years old], [Boys 14-18 years old], [Girls under 18] will win bigger prizes. All contestants will be given smaller prizes.

Selection for the grand final in Biarritz, France

First place winners of each age category will be in competition with each other to win a ticket to the grand final in Biarritz, France. Only one overall winner from Each of the 5 events can advance to the final in Biarritz.

The of the Hawk European Tour

Each of the 5 winners from each of the 5 pre selection events will compete against each other in Biarritz. The winner of the Biarritz event will win a trip for 2 people to the United States for 1 week. The minimum commercial value of the prize is 1000 Euros per person. Total prize value is 2000 Euros minimum. The dates for the USA trips will be chosen by the winner. Wilfried Stephan must be notified of the dates 2 months before the date of travel.

If the winner is still a minor for the trip to the USA, they must be accompanied by one of their legal guardians. In the case of a winner becoming 18 years of age before the trip to the USA, they can travel with the person of their choice.

The voyage does not include visa or document charges, air taxes, travel insurance or personal spending money. The winner and their travelling companion must also pay for transport from their homes to (and from) the departure airport.

Important : **travel insurance is entirely the responsibility of the competitors.** Hawk Clothing will not be responsible for problems concerning travel insurance.

The second Prize winner will win :

3 Sweatshirts, 1 Jacket, 3 t-shirts, 3 jumpers, 2 trousers, 1 back pack, 1 wallet, 1 pair of socks, underwear, 1 belt, 1 hat, plus(depending on the collection) 2 shorts and 2 sweat shirts. The apparel can be selected by the winner from our clothing brochures.

The 3rd Prize winner will win :

A complete board set-up signed by Tony Hawk .

All other contestants will win a small prize.
